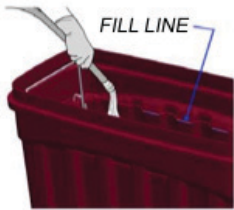


SOAK SYSTEMS

Deep Soak Cleaning System

TANK MAINTENANCE

DAILY USE



TO FILL THE TANK

1 – Remove lid and fill the tank with cold water to the marks 6" below the top of the **Deep Soak Cleaning System** tank. **Do not use hot water or overfill the tank.**



2 – Add one full bottle of DSC Cleaner Concentrate to the water in the tank. Replace lid.

MONTHLY CLEAN AND REFILL



3 – Open drain valve and allow the tank to drain into a floor or mop sink drain.

4 – After draining – remove the rack – turn tank on its side and rinse the remaining soil into the drain using clean water.

5 – Close the drain valve and replace the rack.

6 – Refill the tank using the Fill Instructions (Steps 1&2).



1 – Pre-rinse the soiled baking pans, pots, utensils, skewers, filters and other equipment – then place them into the tank. Completely cover all items with the solution.

2 – After soaking is complete – Remove the lid, raise the rack and allow the solution to drain into the tank. Remove the cleaned items and drain the solution from each item back into the tank.

3 – Wash, rinse and sanitize the soaked items before placing back in service.

CAUTION: Contains DSC Cleaner Solution. May cause eye and skin irritations. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

EYES: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Remove contact lenses, if worn. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

SKIN: In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Contact a physician if irritation occurs.

INGESTION: If large quantities of solution are swallowed, contact a physician immediately. Do NOT induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DO NOT ADD ANY CHEMICALS TO THIS SOLUTION. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
